

How to Make Rosette with Scarf/Sash

Items required:

- Scarf/sash
- Rubberband or clear hair tie (or similar color to tartan)
- Safety pins
- Brooch

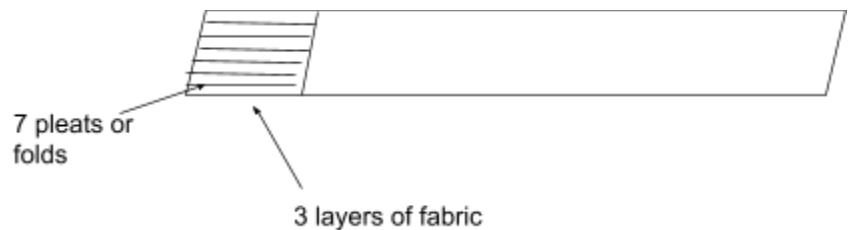
Instructions:

- 1) Completely unfold scarf or sash
- 2) Take one end of the scarf and fold over ~6 inches
Note: the larger the fold the larger the rosette circle



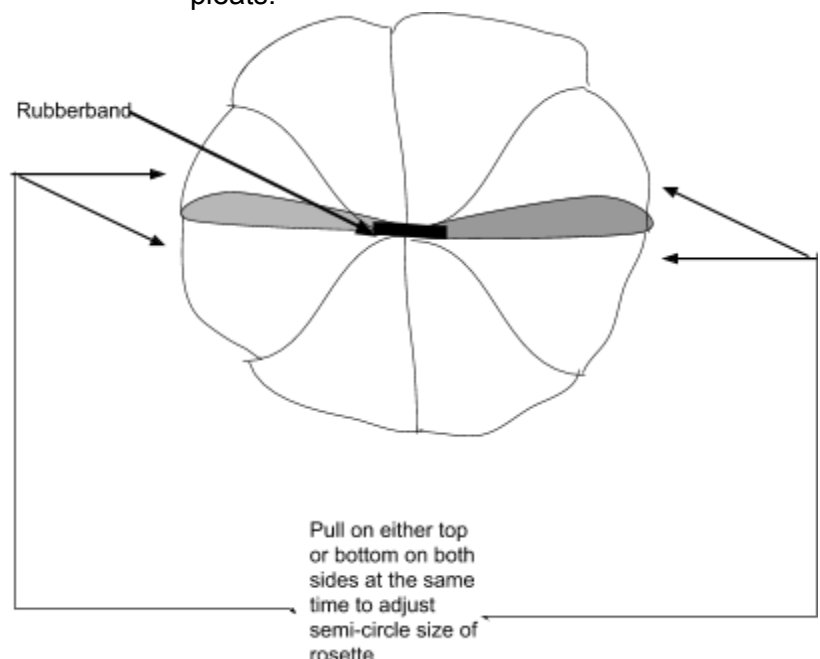
Note: You can choose to keep the fringe in or out of the folds. It can be slightly more difficult to fold with the fringe outside, but it is your personal preference.

- 3) Once folded, you should have 3 layers of fabric. With the 3 layers, you will then pinch the fabric together to form a pleat 7 times, gathering the fabric between your fingers as you fold.



Tie rubber band in middle of pleats

- 4) Once you have all 7 pleats created, wrap a rubber band around the midpoint of your pleats.



- 5) Once the rubber band is tightened, you should see your rosette form, and you can then adjust the size of either side of the

Pull on either top or bottom on both sides at the same time to adjust semi-circle size of rosette
